

# IB Testing Student Information

## May 2017

### Testing Dates and Location

- All IB tests will take place at Crossroads Church @ 2721 E. Millbrook Road
- Morning test start times vary from 8:00am to 9:00am. Please consult schedule for specific testing start times.
- Afternoon test start times vary from 12:00pm to 1:00pm. Please consult schedule for specific testing start times.
- **Plan to arrive 30 minutes prior to the exam start time.** Be sure to account for morning traffic, finding the location, etc. Better to be 15 minutes early than 15 minutes late!
- If you have a morning exam, you are to report directly to the testing location. You are not required to return to school following the completion of that day's examination period.
- If you have an afternoon exam, you are required to attend 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> block classes before being dismissed to prepare for your exam. Failure to adhere to this policy will result in an unexcused absence and any corresponding consequences.

### What to bring to the testing session

- Student testing schedule with candidate number
- Black or blue pens for writing all exams
- Pencils (#2) for multiple-choice questions and for drawing graphs and diagrams
- Ruler
- Magnifying glass is allowed for map work on Geography resource booklet.
- Calculator (math and science exams only)
- Wristwatch (no other personal clock/time piece will be allowed)

### What NOT to bring to the testing session

- Food or drink (water is the ONLY exception)
- Cell phones, digital cameras, PDAs, personal radio/stereo, mp3, or any other form of electronic communication or disruption
- Dictionaries (English or otherwise)
- Textbooks, notebooks, or other instructional books
- White-out or other correction fluids
- Highlighters
